OUR HISTORY

Established in 1870 Temple Israel serves as a beacon for meaningful Jewish living in New York City. From its founding on East 125th Street in Harlem as Congregation Hand in Hand, Temple Israel's mission has been to preserve the continuity of Jewish tradition and to strengthen the Jewish community. The congregation broke ground on its current building in 1964 and construction was completed three years later. With its Brutalist architecture, East 75th Street has been Temple Israel's home for more than one half century.





TRANSFORMING OUR SACRED SPACES

An ambitious vision for the future of Temple Israel has brought us to this pivotal moment in the life of our congregation. The scope of this historic renovation project includes upgrades to all areas of TI living.



WORSHIP

Upon the completion of **PHASE I** of the construction, our Main Sanctuary will be visually, technologically and mechanically modernized.

Our intimate Chapel will be upgraded and expanded and the newly enclosed Courtyard will be a welcoming new space for community gathering with enhanced security.

LEARNING

PHASE II will take us to the upper floors of 4, 5 & 6 which houses our Early Childhood Learning Center and the hub of our Life Long Learning Department. In this phase our weathered building façade will be repaired and cleaned.



COMMUNITY

PHASE III will include upgrades to the Ballroom level of the building. Carpet, lighting, wallpaper, audio visual equipment and restrooms will be upgraded and/or replaced.
